1. Rectification in credits from 12 to 16 in the course work for the Ph.D. program proposed to be introduced in the Department of Art Education in the Faculty of Fine Arts.
2. Deletion of the proposal of creation of the non-teaching posts of Instructors and Studio Assistants.

The Terms of Reference of the Committee were briefed by the Vice-Chancellor as follows:

Review the role, objectives and organisation structure of the NCC, and suggest measures to enhance the contribution of NCC to youth empowerment, nation building and national integration. (ii) Suggest measures for utilisation of NCC Cadets as trained human resources to contribute in national developmental efforts in various sectors after completion of school/college education of the Cadets. (iii) Suggest measures to engage with NCC alumni, and utilise their experience, expertise and skills on a long-term basis towards national developmental efforts and in the task of nation building. (iv) Analyse and recommend improvements in components of NCC training, including thorough introduction of concepts like “Ek Bharat, Shresh Bharat”, Border Security, Coastal Security etc. (v) Suggest measures to nurture NCC cadets as grassroots community leaders, motivators and catalytic agents for socio-economic progress. (vi) Analyse and recommend improvements in training philosophy with a view to align NCC with Armed Forces, including thorough use of their training infrastructure. (vii) Study and recommend international best practices for similar youth organisations for inclusion in NCC’s curriculum. (viii) Recommend measures to enhance NCC’s reach across the country, with a special emphasis on border areas and under-developed areas. (ix) Review and recommend amendment to the NCC Act, 1948. (x) Review of any pending recommendation made by any expert committee in the past where relevant. (xi) Any other issue which serve to enhance the stated objective or effectiveness in achieving delivery of outcomes.

The Vice Chancellor further summarized the House that since the Govt. of India is keen to enhance the structure of the NCC for the youth empowerment, national integration etc., therefore, the proposal for inclusion of NCC as a General Elective Credit Course as proposed by Col. Raj Kumar, SC Adm. Officer, NCC Gp HQ Delhi ‘C’, New Delhi be discussed in detail to make it a part of Curriculum of PG/UG Courses in the University.

After due deliberations, the Majlis (AC) resolved to approve the proposal in principle and authorise the Vice-Chancellor to constitute a Committee to frame out the modalities for inclusion of this course under CBCS in the University.
