

The programme was attended by 40 participants from various universities and colleges across the country.


MIS Update

In this Quarter

- In the Curriculum Module, data for *Subject Paper Allocation* were modified as new papers were added to the list/group of subsidiary subjects for courses in the Faculty of Social Sciences.
- The courses, MFA/BFA/Diploma/Certificate, of the Department of Fine Arts and Art Education that was earlier part of the Faculty of Education, were transferred to the newly created Faculty of Fine Arts comprising of six new Departments. All the existing students in the above courses were also transferred to this new Faculty.
- ♦ A new department Department of Biotechnology has been created. The B.Sc./M.Sc.(Biotechnology) courses which were earlier running under the Department of Bio-Sciences, were transferred to this new department. A revised Curriculum was designed for B.Sc/M.Sc. (Bio Technology). All the students of the above courses were also transferred to the Department of Biotechnology.

Operationalization of Stores Module

The Stores Management module has been operationalized for IT-related purchases. The module has been added in the MIS which contains complete Information regarding various stages of sales & purchase activities, such as

- ♦ Item/Item Detail Information.
- Supplier Information,
- Item opening balance Information,
- Tax related information,
- Individual Item rate Detail information,
- Stock Information, etc.

The purpose of this system is to generate the Proposal/Quotation for Purchase, Generation of Purchase Order, Maintain the Challan /Bill Details and finally maintain the Stock of the Items. It covers all the major activities involved during the sales & purchase system. Through this system, one can trace the exact stock position at any point of time or at the end of a financial year. Furthermore, this system generates Gate Pass or Return Details of Items. The CIT has already tested this module and placed the Purchase Order and other transaction through this system.




Graphical Representation of Admission 2008-2009 of Faculties/Centre and Schools


Graphical Representation of Admission 2008-2009 of the Centres



Category-wise break-up of **Admissions 2008-2009**




During July to September 2008, there were 2,28,765 visits to the website, which is almost 25% of the total visits to the site 8,77,285 since 12 May 2006.



Jobs/Placement/Proforma/MOM/Research/Others



The ten most popular website categories that have been surfed by the users are shown below:





The following chart represents the top ten most preferred data download sites for the third quarter of 2008.






