Rules for credit transfer at Post Graduate level

The University will permit Post graduate students belonging to the Faculties of Social Sciences and of Humanities and Languages to opt for courses outside their parent departments. All M.A. programmes in the above mentioned Faculties have a total credit value of 64. Of these 12.5 percent of the total credit value or 8 credits may be earned from outside the parent department if a student so desires. Not more than one paper may be offered from outside the Department in any one Semester.

<u>Rules</u>

- 1. Students will have to opt for out of Department courses in the prescribed form in the first week of Semester I/or the date notified.
- A consolidated list of courses available with timings will be notified by 1 August, 2012 in the prescribed format.
- The Head of the Department will be responsible for maintaining records of students opting courses offered by their Departments.
- 4. The Department concerned will decide on the maximum number of students to be enrolled in a particular course that it offers.
- 5. The last date for registration will be the last day of First week of Semester I.
- 6. No changes in class timings will be made by individual Departments.
- 7. Students should look up the detailed course content of a course before opting for it.
- 8. The Course Option Card should be filled in quadruplicate. One copy deposited with the parent Department, one copy with the Department whose course is being offered, one copy in the Dean office, Faculty of Humanities and Languages and one copy will be retained by the student.
