

PROF ABDUL MUBEEN: Prof. Abdul Mubeen, Graduated in Mechanical Engineering from Jabalpur University in 1964, completed his M. Tech from IIT Bombay in 1967. He obtained Ph D from IIT Kanpur in 1974. He started teaching at MACT Bhopal and also taught at IIT Bombay & Michigan Technological University USA for 3 years and finally joined Jamia Millia Islamia in 1985. He served as HOD Mechanical Engg. and also as Dean, Faculty of Engg. JMI. He started B.E Courses in the Faculty of Engg& Technology. He shouldered the responsibility of Construction of Faculty Building during VII Plan period.

Prof.Mubeen conducted researches, supervised 6 Ph D theses, 40 M. Tech. Dissertations and published more than 100 papers in National and International Conferences and Journals. He authored 12 Books.
