Qualification Essential

- (i) First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech).
- (ii) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.

(b) **D/o Applied Science & Humanities**

- (i) One Guest Teacher (Physics) (against vacant position)
- (ii) One Guest Teacher (Mathematics) (against vacant position)

Qualification

- I. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. Candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Qualification

- I. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

- iii. Candidates, who are, M. Ed. Degree with at least 55% marks or have been awarded a Ph. D. - 3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC /any such affiliating body /State Government, from time to time for the positions of principal and Lecturers shall be mandatory;

OR

- 1. M.A in Education with 55% marks (or and equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);
- 2. B.Ed with at least 55% (marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);
- 3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC/any such affiliating body /State Government, from time to time for the position of principal and lecturer, shall be mandatory.

- 1. A Master Degree in subject with 50% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed):
- 2. M.Ed with at least 55% marks(or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and
- 3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC/any such affiliating body /State Government, from time to time for the position of principal and lecturer, shall be mandatory
