Jamia administers BDS and B.Tech Entrance Tests with aplomb

Putting behind past fortnight's disruption in its examination process, Jamia administered BDS and B.Tech Entrance tests with aplomb. The B.Tech entrance examination was conducted flawlessly today in all the notified test-centres in the country and same was the case with BDS test that was taken by students day before yesterday.

There were around 40,000 applicants for overall **350 B.Tech seats** in various branches of engineering and over 6000 applicants for **50 BDS seats**. Over 75% applicants appeared for the B.Tech re-test today and over 80% applicants took the BDS examination on June 25, 2015. Both the tests took place at all the notified test centres in a very fair and peaceful atmosphere.

The university administration has shown determination to stamp out any trace of irregularity in order to uphold the sanctity of the examination process. Prof. Talat Ahmad, Vice- Chancellor, Jamia Millia Islamia randomly visited examination centres at Rohini and Pitampura in North West Delhi and at Moti Bagh in New Delhi District today.
