FINDINGS

The understanding of the idea of caliphate in Islam is influenced by the approach one takes towards identifying the sources of Islamic teachings and understanding the Quran.

If one takes the approach of including the consensus of the companions, as a source of legislation, then the understanding of the idea of caliphate may differ significantly.
