The Hony. Director, IQAC extended his thanks and requested the Representative of M/s Matrix Infosoftware to give presentation of the software initially developed to strengthen the database of IQAC. Thereafter, presentation of the Online Webpage was made comprising of 06 modules as per the following:

1. Administration
2. Teachers (University)
3. Teachers (Schools)
4. Non-Teaching Staff
5. Students Feedback
6. Online Front Interface Section and Job Post/Apply



The Hony. Director apprised the need and importance of creating a database for IQAC. He informed that all the faculty members would be able to upload their resume after registering at the webpage. The webpage would have an option of nodal and subnodal officers as sub-admins to upload/extract information as and when needed. The IQAC Nodal Officers at Deptt/Centre can act as sub-admin. A detailed performa for CV of Faculty/Staff members was also presented and invited the suggestions/modification/addition, if any, with the members. Minor suggestions were suggested which would be incorporated. It was opined that once the CV form is completed by the faculty/staff, it can be converted into online system and would help in extracting information needed for different ranking agencies. The portal will also hold the information related to IQAC data and activity, ranking related information, NAAC reports and minutes of the meetings and several other information.

Prof. M N Doja, raised a concern about the security of the JMI website as initially it was thought to link/host the IQAC webpage at [www.jmi.ac.in](http://www.jmi.ac.in). After detailed deliberation and discussion, it was recommended that the IQAC shall host on a separate domain and create its own database independently. The issue of authenticating the data that will be uploaded on the IQAC webpage was also deliberated and was decided that verification will be done by the HoD concerned for authenticity before uploading online wherein the Nodal Officers could be involved. The hard copy may be sent to IQAC.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
