- The BOS has congratulated Dr.S.R.T.P.SUGUNAKARARAJU for successfully coordinating the Refresher Course in Human Rights and Social Inclusion(interdisciplinary) from 30th July to 20th August 2015 at the HRDC Jamia Millia Islamia.
- The BoS endorsed the new syllabus for M.A. Political Science, M.A. Public Administration and M.A. Human Rights and Duties Education effective from the new academic year, 2015-16
- The BoS congratulated Dept. of Political Science for being awarded for the first time, UGC-SAP, DRS- I, for a period of five years, 2015-2020 and also congratulated the Coordinator: Prof. Mohammed Badrul Alam and Deputy Coordinator, Prof. Rumki Basu

The Interview and Selection of Ph.D Candidates:
