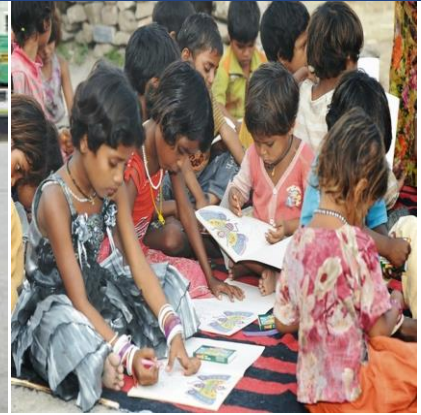




Panel Discussion and Research Consultation
