ABOUT THE CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME

ICSSR funds and promotes Research Methodology and Capacity Building Programmes in Universities, Colleges and Research Institutes to enhance the research capabilities of young research scholars and early-career academics and to promote a deeper understanding of the theoretical and methodological concepts of research.

A comprehensive understanding of the methodologies and strategies employed in research is essential for the development of high-quality research. Although the philosophical underpinnings of social science research are universally shared, each discipline has created its own distinctive theoretical framework and research methodologies. Researchers engaging in an interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary study need to familiarize themselves with the methodologies of disciplines beyond their own area of competence. Furthermore, there are a plethora of areas in which a proficient researcher must improve their skills, from the initial stage of the research problem to the final reporting and publication of the results, in order to make a substantial contribution to the advancement of knowledge in their respective fields.

This proposed Capacity-building Programme (CBP) is on the Importance of Cultural Studies in Social Sciences: Methodologies, Ethics and Interdisciplinary Approaches. Cultural studies (As an interdisciplinary field) explore the complex relationship between culture and society. It focuses on how cultural practices and institutions influence human behaviour, identity and social structures. In social sciences, it provides a critical framework to understand social phenomena, from identity politics and migration patterns to nationalism and globalization. In the post globalisation era, socio-political and economic environments are being transformed day by day. It is making cultural connections more complex and complicating. Therefore, we require a thorough understanding of cultural dynamics those influence our social reality.

In academia, young faculty members often encounter challenges in grasping the critical role of cultural studies within broader social science frameworks. Therefore, this capacity-

building program aims to equip them with the necessary tools, methodologies and theoretical perspectives to analyse social phenomena through a cultural lens.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

The primary objective of this course is to familiarize participants with the significance of cultural studies in social sciences and enhance their research methodology skills. The specific objectives of this course are as follows:

- ❖ To Develop Critical Awareness: To cultivate an in-depth understanding of the intersections between culture, society and politics. And, how these interactions influence contemporary social issues.
- ❖ To Enhance Research Skills: To provide participants with the methodological tools necessary to conduct qualitative and quantitative research in cultural studies. It would focus on ethnography, case studies and mixed-methods approaches.
- ❖ To Promote Ethical Awareness: To enhance understanding of the ethical implications associated with cultural studies research, particularly with regard to various ethnic groups, marginalized communities and other sensitive subjects.
- ❖ To Improve Academic Writing and Proposal Development: To guide participants in academic writing, concentrating on cultural studies. And, to train them in formulating research design, data analysis and the dissemination of results in reports, articles as well as proposals.
- **❖ To Assist in Capacity Building for Field Research**: To equip participants with practical skills for conducting field research in cultural studies, exclusively in multicultural and diverse environments.

Moreover, this research methodology training Programme is designed to facilitate the initial phase of designing and planning a research work in social sciences by giving faculty members a clear overview of the basic elements of research writing common to social sciences. The training program will introduce the essential elements of writing a thesis (issue, contexts, texts, methodology and voice). After introducing these concepts, the training Program will give faculty members the opportunity to articulate these concepts in their own research issues. The Training Programme will orient the participants about various components of research, i.e., epistemology, methodology and method, and simultaneously organize discussion sessions on how to write research proposals, research thesis and research articles during their research work. The training Programme will focus on developing the skills of identifying the basic elements of description, analysis and argument, and incorporating them into their writing practice.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the Training Programme, the participants will be able to:

- Become familiar with the core components of a research work, i.e., writing synopsis and thesis.
- Articulate these components in relation to own research work.
- Engage in critical evaluation of each of these elements in relation to the own research work
- Learn to identify differences between description, analysis and argument in social science writing.

- Learn to conceptualize research paper writing in social sciences.
- Guide participants for collaborative and multidisciplinary research in the areas of social science and allied disciplines.
