DES at a Glance

The Department of Educational Studies (erstwhile Department of Foundations of Education) was carved out of Teachers College in December 1980, and thus, became a part of the Faculty of Education. Initially the Department began its modest journey by launching two academic programs; Ph.D. (Education) and M.Ed. which were compatible with national and international standards. Department which is known today as Department of Educational Studies is an outcome of foresighted and transformational leadership of a number of teacher educators who served here with a missionary zeal. The Department, as part of its continued effort to promote innovation through research and teaching, introduced the M.Phil. Program in 1983 (Now discontinued). To keep abreast with the emerging trends of education, the Department introduced three more programmes; Master in Educational Planning and Administration (M.A.EPA) in 1985-86, M.Ed. (Elementary Education) program in 1997 and Post Graduate Diploma in Educational Management (PGDEM) in 2004, and Master in Early Childhood Development (M.A.ECD).

The **1st International Research Poster Competition (IRPC)** is a scholarly initiative aimed at providing a dynamic platform for research scholars and early career researchers to present their empirical and systematic research work. The event seeks to promote academic dialogue, foster research dissemination, and encourage innovative thinking in the field of education and allied disciplines.

Conducted in a hybrid mode, the event ensures wider participation and accessibility, bringing together participants from diverse geographical and academic backgrounds. It emphasizes quality research, methodological rigor, and meaningful contributions to knowledge.

Kindly Note

Only **empirical studies and systematic research** (including reviews, meta-analyses, and data-driven studies) will be considered. Limited slots are available, Early submission is encouraged, Participants must adhere to guidelines.

Registration cum Submission Process

The competition will follow a two-stage submission process:

Stage 1: Abstract Submission

Participants are required to submit an abstract of their research work for initial screening.

Stage 2: Poster Submission and Presentation

Only shortlisted participants will be invited to submit their research posters and present them during the event in either online or offline mode. Details for poster submission will be communicated for the accepted abstracts.

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Submission Guidelines

Abstract Submission Guidelines (Stage 1)

- Abstracts must be based on empirical or systematic research only
- Word Limit: 250–300 words
- The abstract should clearly include:
 - Title of the Study
 - Author Details
 - Objectives
 - Methodology
 - Key Findings / Expected Outcomes
 - Keywords (3–5)

Formatting Requirements:

- Font: Times New Roman, Font Size: 12, Line Spacing: 1.5, Alignment: Justified

Screening and Acceptance

- All abstracts will undergo a double blind peer-review process.
- Selection will be based on Relevance to theme, Quality and originality, and Clarity and coherence.
- Conceptual papers without data or systematic analysis will not be considered.
- Acceptance notification will be communicated via email only.

Certification

Certificates will be provided to all registered participants. Exciting prizes will be given for best posters in online and offline categories separately.
