

ANTI-RAGGING DAY (18th August 2026)

The Department of Tourism and Hospitality Management (DTHM), Jamia Millia Islamia, observed **Anti-Ragging Day** on 18th August 2026 to raise awareness, foster empathy, and uphold a zero-tolerance policy against ragging on campus. The event saw enthusiastic participation from students across multiple batches and programs in speech and poster making competitions reflecting a shared commitment to building a safe, inclusive, and supportive academic environment. These activities reflect UGC's advisory to institutions to conduct competitions (speech, poster, slogan, etc.) and awareness programmes.

The program commenced with an address by the **Head of Department, Prof. (Dr.) Sarah Hussain**, who underscored the absolute necessity of maintaining a strictly ragging-free campus. The address emphasized institutional safeguards, UGC compliance guidelines, and the collective ethical responsibility of senior batches to welcome new entrants with mentorship rather than intimidation.



To foster constructive engagement and creative advocacy, the department organized two events: **Speech Competition and Poster Making Competition**. Participants actively engaged in discussions addressing the psychological ramifications of ragging. Key themes explored in these events included the direct impact of harassment on student's mental health and academic focus, creating a culture of approachable peer mentorship, reporting mechanisms and building institutional trust. Participants were

evaluated on key parameters including clarity of thought, oratorical delivery and relevance.

The Poster Making Competition saw participants translate anti-ragging themes into striking visual narratives. The entries were formally evaluated based on three distinct criteria- Thematic Relevance, Creativity & Originality, Visual Impact & Aesthetic Appeal. Both competitions were adjudicated by faculty members **Dr. Akash** and **Chef Siddharth**. Both events encouraged participants translate anti-ragging themes into striking visual and oral narratives. The Programme was convened by Student Advisors, Dr Nusrat Yasmeen and Mr. Mudassir Khan and coordinated by Research Scholars- Ms. Shreya, Ms. Bisma , Ms. Aiman and Ms. Trishla.
