- **Dean Student Welfare (DSW)**, emphasized co-curricular involvement through NMBA & Student Activities.




- **Mr. Ajay (DTHM)**, shared insights on Students' Wellbeing Activities, focusing on mental health awareness and support systems.




➤ **Prof. Sarah Hussain (DTHM)**, presented on Grooming Standards, stressing personal presentation and professional etiquette.
