


Department of Tourism and Hospitality Management Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi Vigilance Awareness Week (26 October to 1st November of 2021)


Competition and Slogan Writing Competition on the theme "Break the corruption chain".

Before announcing the competition, a small quiz was organized for all the audience and the participants to spread the awareness about central vigilance commission (CVC).


The slogans were assessed and judged on the basis of creativity, uniqueness, combination of the words and participant's word about their slogan. Winners were awarded with ecertificates.


AWARD WINNING SLOGANS
