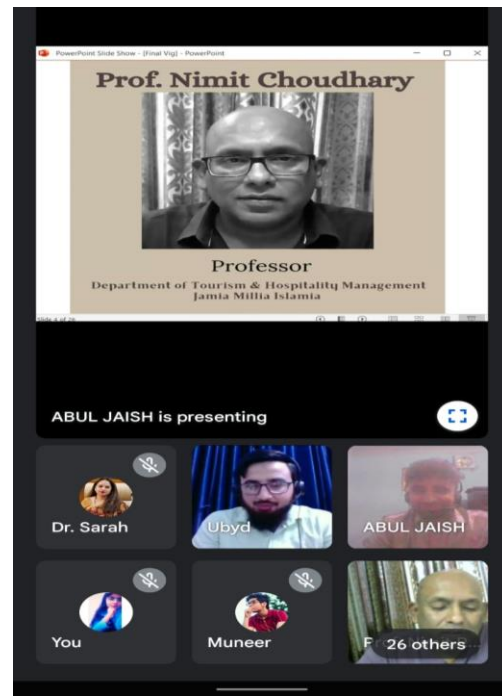

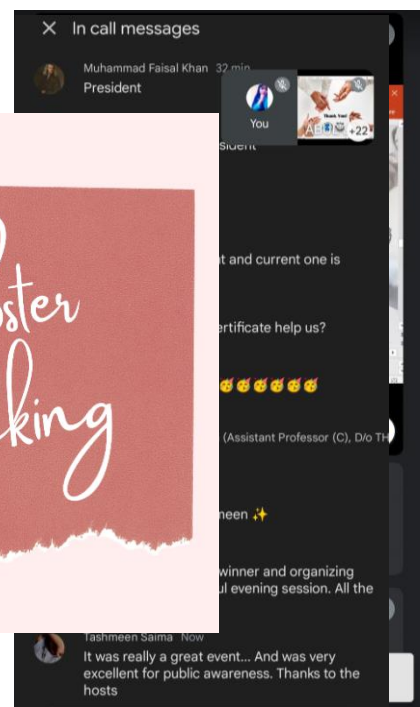
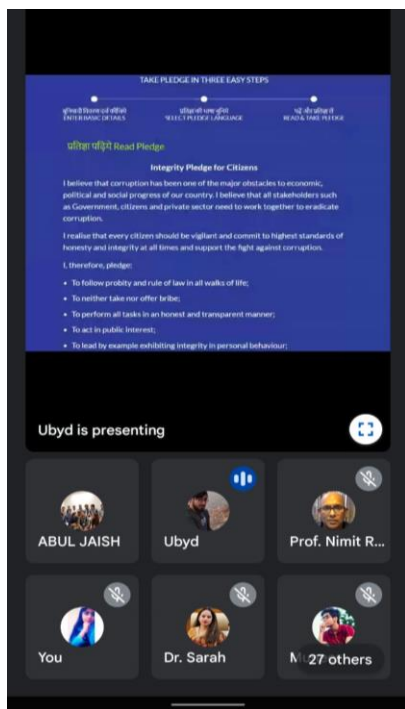
The slogans were assessed and judged on the basis of creativity, uniqueness, combination of the words and participant’s word about their slogan. Winners were awarded with e-certificates.
