Eligibility

All in service teachers, post-doctoral research associates, scientists, project fellows in higher education working in universities and colleges that are included under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, even though they may not yet be fit under Section 12 (B), are invited to participate in the programme.  3. Click "Apply for Other Programmes."
 4. Apply for and select Short Term Programme.
 5. Select centre name as Jamia Millia Islamia, with date (07.10.2026 to 13.10.2026)
 6. Fill other details & Upload NOC or an undertaking* in PDF format of less than 1MB.
 7. Submit your form.
 8. You will receive an automated confirmation email from mmc.ugc portal.
 9. You will receive confirmation & all further information from mmttcparticipants@jmi.ac.in close to the beginning of the programme.
- *Those who could not submit the NOC at the time of registration will have to submit it before the end of the course, failing which the certificate will not be issued.*
