Her poems have appeared in literary journals across the UK and India, and her work has been anthologized in collections out through Penguin, Hachette, Simon & Schuster and Harper Collins. Her poem 'Another Life' was selected by the Edinburgh UNESCO city of literature for the tramlines project, the poem now appears on the tramway in Edinburgh. She is currently working on a novel.
