

## **Report Vigilance Awareness Week**

Faculty of Social Sciences and Subject Associations- Department of Political Science and B. A. Programme celebrated Vigilance Awareness Week (27th October to 2nd November 2020) with the theme “Vigilant India, Prosperous India” on 31st October 2020 at 11:00 am on Google Meet. There were 26 students as the audience and the programme began with the Welcome Address by Associate Professor Naved Jamal, Department of Political Science, Jamia Millia Islamia.

The programme was a two-fold event with the first session was a lecture series held from 11:00 am - 12:00 pm in which three experts were invited to speak-
