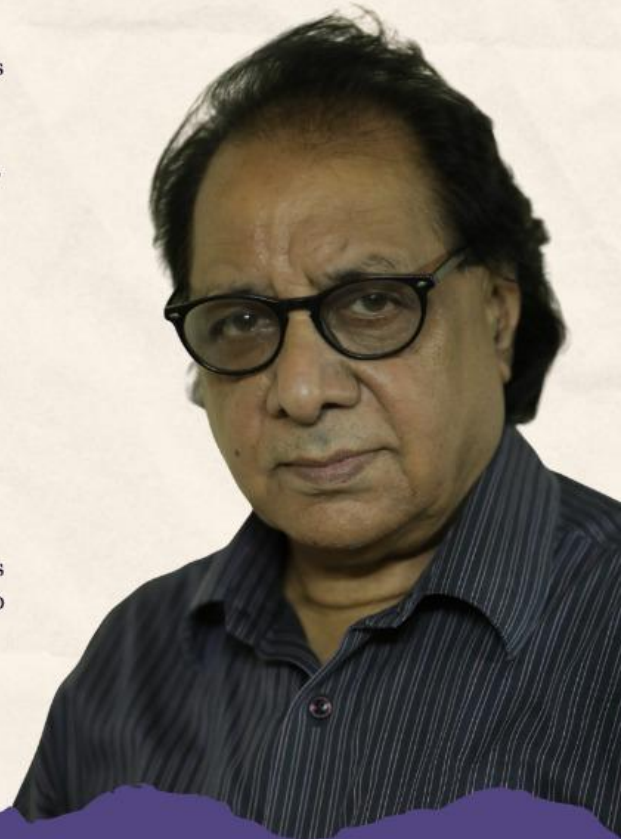


M. S. Swaminathan's Societal Impact: Screening of Two Documentaries
