

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

To achieve smooth and sustained economic growth the developing countries like India need to enhance the productivity and efficiency of various sectors along with its factors of production and hence it is imperative to analysis the performance of these sectors by measuring the productivity and technical efficiency.

Technical efficiency means the capacity of a firm to produce maximum output by a given set of inputs or by a minimum quantity of inputs (Kumbhakar and Lovell, 2003).

The literature pointed out that measurement of technical efficiency of firm/ industry is important because it not only determines the level of efficiency of a firm but also contributes economic growth of an economy (Fahmy-Abdullah et al., 2017).

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

The main objective of this workshop is to impart the practical knowledge on the estimation of Productivity and Efficiency and its applications in empirical research.
