Finding

The study has highlighted the scope and presence of leadership of women students in activism spaces as well as mass movements. It has also assessed the influence and impact of feminism on women student activists and hence has broadened the scope of understanding the contemporary issues and concerns of women student activists and their relationship with feminism. The research has filled the gaps in the existing literature available on contemporary feminist issues which lead women students to participate in student activism and has profiled many contemporary women student leaders who have become a role model for the generations to come. It has also highlighted the specific contemporary movements and campaigns led by women students in India that have brought a positive social change in the society as well as in the arena of academics.

The study also outlines the reasons, issues and concerns attributing to which women take part in student activism. Other important findings like influence of feminist thought on their activism, impact of intersectionality on the life of women student activists and impact of pandemic on student activism have also been discussed. The key findings of the study revealed several feminist overtones related to participation of women in student activism.
