NOTE: The selected candidates are advised to contact the Office of the Dr. K.R.N. Centre for Dalit and Minorities Studies immediately to complete the admission formalities 2017 by 14/12/17.

Candidates shall submit the following documents at the time of admission to the Ph.D. Programme:

- Attested Photograph of the candidate.
- Synopsis duly signed by the candidate on every page and the signature of Supervisor(S) on first and last page.
- Proof of Local Residential Address.
- Attested copy of Matriculation (Class X) for verification of date of birth.
- Attested copy of Graduation Degree.
- Attested copy of Post-graduation Degree.
- Attested copy of Mark Sheet of Post-graduation having proof obtaining at least 55% marks.
- Copy of Caste Certificate, in case of reserved category.
- Character Certificate (in original), not more than 6 months old. In case the period extends more than 6 months then the candidate should submit a declaration certificate with respect to the intervening period, if any, after completing the qualifying course including the statement of character on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.10/- duly attested by Notary Public or Oath Commissioner.
- Migration Certificate (in original) must be provided within one month of the date of completion of admission, failing which admission is liable to be cancelled.
- No Objection Certificate from the employer, if employed (in original).
- If the candidate is unemployed, an Undertaking on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.10/- duly attested by Notary Public or Oath Commissioner.
- A Consent Letter from the Co-Supervisor(S) specifying his/her field of specialization with full correspondence address.
- Research Visa within one month of the admission (For Foreign Students).
