1. Guest Teachers under the Regular Courses will be paid honorarium of Rs. 50,000/- per month and will share the equal work load as shared by the Asstt. Professor (contractual).

- One guest teacher for teaching of Sculpture
- One guest teacher for teaching of Digital Composition in Painting

Qualification

Eligibility (A or B):-

A.

- (i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be:-

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges / Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) Ph.D. degree has been awarded to the candidate in a regular mode
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which, at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in Conferences / seminars supported/funded/sponsored by the UGC/AICTE/ICSSR or any other similar agency.
- Note 1: The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affair) of the University concerned.
- Note 2: The clearance of NET / SLET / SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (like SLET/SET).

- **B.** A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's degree, who has:-
 - (i) Studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s)
 - (ii) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR / Doordarshan;
 - (iii) Has the ability to explain, with logical reasoning the subject concerned; and
 - (iv) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.

Desirable for Sculpture for Department of Painting

The candidate should have through knowledge of working with different materials such as Clay, Terracotta, Wood, Stone Metal Casting etc.

Desirable for Digital Composition for Department of Painting

The candidate should have studied Computer Graphics / Animation and Multimedia and will versed of working with various software

OR

The candidate should possess any certificate or Diploma in Computers from a recognized Institute.

Note:-

1. Applicants are requested to submit the prescribed Application Forms in the concerned Department, JMI.

2. There will no fee for filling up the application form for the above positions.

- 3. The concerned Department/Centre will screen the application of the candidates and will call for interview accordingly.
- 4. The engagement of the Guest Teachers will be w.e.f. the date of taking classes (but not before the date of Local Selection Committee) for the Academic Session 2022-23 or till vacancy exits or till further orders, whichever is earlier.
- 5. Selection against vacancy shall not confer on the appointee any right of permanent appointment/regularization.

6. Separate application should be submitted for each post.

7. Relaxation, if any, shall be as per the UGC guidelines and other regulatory bodies.

8. Number of positions advertized herein are provisional and may vary.

9. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit. The University may constitute a Screening Committee to scrutinize the applications and short-listing the candidates.

10. Eligibility of candidates will be determined as on the last date of submission of application forms.
