Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges /Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

4. The engagement of the Guest Teachers will be w.e.f. the date of taking classes (*but not before the date of Local Selection Committee*) for the **Academic Session 2022-23** or till vacancy exits or till further orders, whichever is earlier.
5. Selection against vacancy shall not confer on the appointee any right of permanent appointment/regularization.
6. Separate application should be submitted for each post.
7. Relaxation, if any, shall be as per the UGC guidelines and other regulatory bodies.
8. Number of positions advertized herein are provisional and may vary.
9. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit. The University may constitute a Screening Committee to scrutinize the applications and short-listing the candidates.
