1. (ii) One Asstt. Professor (contractual) for Civil Engg. discipline

Qualification

- i. First Class Master's Degree in Structural/Earthquake Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech.)
- ii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
 1. Teaching, research industrial and/or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 2. Papers presented at Conference and/or in refereed journals.

1 (iii) One Asstt. Professor (contractual) for Fine Arts discipline

Qualification

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- iii. "The award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-
 - a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
 - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
 - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;

d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a referred journal;

e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs) / Dean (University instructions).”

iv. Without prejudice to the above, NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

OR

i. A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:

1. First class Diploma in Visual (Fine) arts discipline from the recognized Institution of India/Abroad;
2. Five years of experience of holding regular regional/National exhibitions/Workshops with evidence; and
3. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

1. Only candidates registered with the Council of Architecture (COA) under the provision of the Architects Act, 1972 shall be eligible for the above posts.
2. Applicants are requested to kindly submit the prescribed Application Form in the Department of Architecture, JMI.
3. The Department will screen the application of the candidates and will call for interview accordingly.
4. The engagement of the guest teachers will be w.e.f. the date of taking classes (but not before the date of Local Selection Committee) for the Academic Session 2018-19 or till vacancy exits or till further orders whichever is earlier.
5. Selection against vacancy shall not confer on the appointee any right of permanent appointment/regularization.
6. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit. The University may constitute a Screening Committee to scrutinize the applications and short-listing the candidates.
7. Separate application should be submitted for each post.
8. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's/Graduate level for the SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer) physically and visually handicapped candidates.
9. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the Marks to the Ph.D degree holders who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
10. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% where the grading system is followed by recognized University shall also be considered eligible.
11. The eligibility of candidates will be determined as on the last date of submission of Application forms.
12. Qualifications, experience, etc. will be reckoned as on the last date for receipt of filled-in applications i.e. 23.07.2018. Clear photocopies of all important certificates must be attached with the application. The request for including any documents/information to the application forms after the last date of submission of applications shall not be entertained and no correspondence will be made in this regard.

13. (a) The Jamia reserves the right to evolve a uniform and reasonable criterion for short-listing of eligible candidates, if needed.
14. (b) Jamia also reserves right to give preference to those who possess higher qualifications.
15. Candidate must enclose the attested copies of degrees, diplomas and mark-sheets etc. giving reference of experience/published work with application form.
16. Incomplete application or application on plain paper will not be entertained and is liable to be rejected.
17. Relaxation, if any, shall be as per the UGC guidelines and other regulatory bodies.
18. The Number of positions advertized herein are provisional and may vary.
19. Knowledge of Urdu and Hindi is a desirable qualification for all teaching posts.
20. The University reserves the right to hold/not to hold Selection Committee for any or all of the post (s).
21. Canvassing, in any form or on behalf of the candidate will be a disqualification.
