1. Asstt. Professor (Cinematography)

Essential Qualifications:

- i. Good academic record as defined by the University with at-least 55% marks (or equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree in Mass Communication from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited Indian or Foreign University with Film / Digital Video/ Cinema Production (Cinematography) as a core subject.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) in relevant subject conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. Candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time shall be shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:
- a). The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only.
- b). The Ph.D thesis has been awarded by at least two external examiners.

2. Asstt. Professor (Television)

Essential Qualifications:

- i. Good academic record as defined by the University with at-least 55% marks (or equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree in Mass Communication from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited Foreign University with Production (Video and Television) as a core subject.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant subject conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. Candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:
- a). The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only.
- b). The Ph.D thesis has been awarded by at least two external examiners.
- c). An open Ph.D viva Voce of the candidate has been conducted

3. Asstt. Professor (Online Journalism)

Essential Qualifications:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or equivalent grade) at Master's degree level or an equivalent qualification from an Indian or Foreign University / recognized institution in Communication / Mass Communication / Journalism with Online Journalism or Multimedia Journalism as a subject. Candidates, besides fulfilling the above qualification, should have cleared the eligibility test for lectures conducted by UGC or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- ii. NET" shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as lecturer for those with post-graduate degree.
- iii. Candidate, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D degree), Regulations, 2009 or 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities. Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:
- a). The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only.

4. Asstt. Professor (Theatre)

Essential qualifications: (A or B)

- A. i). Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.
 - ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET

or

who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, or 2016, and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme, prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions, subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in the regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars supported/funded/ sponsored by the UGC/CSIR/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

Note:

- 1. The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.
- NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which the NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

- Been a professional artist with three years' Bachelor degree/Post Graduate Diploma, with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed), from the National School of Drama, or any other such Institution in India or abroad;

- iii) The ability to explain, with logical reasoning, the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.
