JN TATA ENDOWMENT LOAN SCHOLARSHIPS 2010-2011

JN Tata Endowment Loan Scholarships for the academic year 2010-2011 would be awarded for higher studies abroad in all disciplines and subjects irrespective of course duration (selected course could be either a short term training programme, or a full fledged Master's or doctoral programme). The endowment awards only loan scholarships. However, the selected scholars may also qualify for a gift award. The amount to be awarded to each scholar by way of loan and gift scholarship is determined on the basis of norms laid down for the purpose, and ranges from Rs 1.50 Lakhs to Rs 8 Lakhs. Requirements: Indian nationals who are graduates of a recognized Indian university with consistently good academic record or students in the final year of the degree course or mid-career professionals planning to go abroad for further research, specialization or training. At the time of submitting the completed applications, candidates need not have the admission/offer letters from the universities to which they have applied for the academic year 2010-2011

To apply: Available from the administrative office of the endowment at Mulla House, 51 M. G. Road, Fort, Mumbai-400001 till February 15, 2010 against Rs 100 in cash or by money order on which the full name and address is to be mentioned.

Submission: March 1 for submission at endowment office.

NAROTAM SEKHSARIA SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGHER STUDIES

The Narotam Sekhsaria Scholarship for higher studies 2010-2011 is a merit-based loan scholarship programme designed for postgraduate studies in India abroad. The amount of the scholarship upto a maximum of Rs 10 lakhs will be decided as per the assessment of the foundation.

Requirements: Indian nationals residing in India under 30 years of age (as on January 31, 2010); graduates of a recognized Indian university (also students in the final year of graduation); student planning to pursue postgraduate studies at prestigious institutes from the fall 2010 semester.

To apply: Download from www.nsscholarship.net. An application fee for Rs 300 by cash/DD/money order in favour of the Narotam Sekhsaria Foundation to Narotam Sekhsaria Foundation, 102, Maker Chamber III, Nariman Point, Mumbai-400021.

Submission: February 20 for submission.
