

SCHOLARSHIP ALERT

CLARENDON SCHOLARSHIP

Clarendon Scholarship is open to international graduate students in all subject areas. The majority of Clarendon scholars are working towards a DPhil (Ph. D). Scholarships are also awarded for two-year graduate courses (MPhil/BPhil/MLitt) or one-year programmes (MSc/MSt.MBA/MFE). Full scholarships cover university (tuition) and college fees, as well as providing an annual grant for living expenses. The grant for living expenses is £13,290 in 2009/10 and the rate increases each year. Scholarships are made for the full duration of the scholar's fee liability, and are usually the same as the standard length of your course. Partial scholarships are offered if scholars-elect secure other funding from an external source. The total funding package from the Clarendon Fund plus external source(s) is the equivalent of a full Clarendon Scholarship. Requirements: Students who are liable to pay the overseas fees rate at the University of Oxford. The scholarship is available for both full and part-time graduate degrees in all subject areas.

To apply: Application for the Clarendon Scholarship should apply simultaneously with their application to Oxford University by ticking the 'Clarendon Fund' box in the University of Oxford Scholarships section of the application form for graduate study at www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/postgraduate_courses/apply/application_format.html. Submission: January 8, for medical sciences and philosophy students; January 22, for all other subjects.
