Dr. Anubha Rajesh is a chair professor at Centre for Early Childhood Development and Research (CECDR), Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI). She has an extensive experience of over 23 years inclusive of designing and conducting research and evaluations, providing technical assistance and program planning in the area of Early Child Development and Education. With over 12 years of experience in management and administration, she has engaged successfully in management, coordination, networking and implementation of a wide range of projects. Her interest areas are working with children in vulnerable categories inclusive of working with children from disadvantaged and indigenous categories, children with disabilities and families and children affected by armed conflict. Her experiences also include technical contribution to developing strategy documents, guidelines and advocacy material, conducting intensive desk reviews, developing analytical frameworks and writing detailed reports in area of early childhood development and education. Her wide experience includes developing data collection protocols, travelling to onsite far-reached field locations, conducting training for field staff, executing interviews, focus groups and conducting assessment of early child care and teacher training programs through observations. As a Principal Investigator, she provided oversight to a range of research and evaluation studies commissioned by diverse funding agencies. As a faculty in esteemed colleges of University of Delhi, and Jamia Millia Islamia, she has a wide experience of transacting curriculum, providing training and technical assistance to students in the field of early childhood education. Dr Rajesh was one of Core Group Members of the National ECCE Curriculum Framework and Quality Standards for ECCE developed by Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD). Dr Rajesh was engaged in developing e-learning training module for Anganwadi workers as a consultant to UNICEF and MWCD. She is member of ECE advisory committee, Vikramshila Education Resource Society and ECCE Executive Committee, Department of Women and Child Development and Mission Shakti, Odisha.

Widely travelled in India and abroad for research and presentations, Dr. Rajesh has several articles and publications to her credit. Her doctoral work in Cambodia, a challenging foreign locale, exemplifies her accomplishments and sensitivity of working in different cultural contexts. The research focused on the vulnerable categories of working women and children, in Especially Difficult Circumstances, affected by armed conflict attempted to gain an insight into lives of working women and accentuate their transformed roles in home and at work.

Dr. Rajesh has worked extensively with disabled children. As a Coordinator of the program for disabled children, she was responsible for managing effective delivery of services, networking with organizations, counseling parents and representing the project at all levels.
