



He is a visiting consultant to the Department of Panchayats & Rural Development, Govt. of Tripura. He was a Full Professor and Head (for two consecutive terms) of the Department of Business Management, Tripura University (A Central University), and the founding Head-In-Charge of the Department of Tourism Administration. He was also a member of the Tripura University Court. He has established Tripura's first business incubator fully funded by the Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India. He was the State Coordinator of the AICTE-sponsored Student Induction Programme for Tripura. He has been nominated as a Mentor by AICTE for newly inducted technical education teachers and as an expert for AICTE's NEAT 2.0 initiative. Having specialized in the information systems domain, his research interest lies in developing blended learning models to realize the objective of Education 4.0 and ICT intervention in tertiary education, ensuring learning continuity. Besides teaching and academic administration, he has worked extensively in curricula design and Innovative Andragogy Development over the last two decades.
