I am to refer to your letter No.1-29/CM/AICTE dated May 12, 2014 addressed to all Vice-Chancellors of Universities on the subject mentioned above and to submit that the University Polytechnic, Jamia Millia Islamia, has been conducting the following Diploma Engineering Courses in daytime and evening:

1.	Diploma in Civil Engineering	60 each in day & evening
2.	Diploma in Computer Engineering	
3.	Diploma in Electrical Engineering	
4.	Diploma in Electronics Engineering	
5.	Diploma in Mechanical Engineering	

The approval of these Diploma Engineering Courses had been granted by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for the session 2001-02 vide letter No. 765-61-021(E)/ET/95 dated 25.07.2001. We have not received any approval to this effect after 2002 in spite of several letters and reminders. However, a letter dated 06.03.2014 (copy enclosed) has been received from AICTE stating that as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 25.04.2013, AICTE cannot process colleges affiliated to the Universities.

Now, the AICTE vide letter dated 12.05.2014 have invited proposals for prior approval of technical courses for the academic year 2014-15 in compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 09.05.2014.

The daytime courses are of three-year duration and the evening courses are of four-year duration. These courses have been approved by the Academic Coucil of the Jamia Millia Islamia.

Ii is further submitted that the Jamia Millia Islamia is a Central University by an Act of Parliament and the University Polytechnic is operative as a Department under its Faculty of Engineering & Technology. It has no connection for its academic or administrative requirements with the Directorate of Technical Education or the Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

It is therefore, requested that approval for the aforementioned Diploma Engineering Day & Evening courses of the University Polytechnic, Jamia Millia Islamia, may kindly be granted by the All India Council for Technical Education at the earliest so that our passed out students do not face any difficulty in getting employment or in pursuing higher studies.

Sir.

As you are aware that AICTE was established as a statutory body under the AICTE act 1987 with a view to ensure coordinated growth and development of Technical Education in the country and for maintenance of standards of Technical Education. The 'technical education' as defined under AICTE act 1987, includes programme of education, research and training in engineering technology, architecture, town planning, management, pharmacy and applied arts &crafts.

AICTE has been granting approvals to Technical Institutes and Colleges requiring affiliation form Universities and Board of Technical Education. However, in view of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Association of Management of Private Colleges Vs AICTE and Adaikalamath College etc Vs AICTE, the AICTE was not able to initiate a step for starting approval process for Technical Institutions / Colleges affiliated and requiring affiliation from Universities for the academic session 2014-15.

This is to inform you that Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dated April 17, 2014 passed in SLP Civil No. 7277/2014 titled as Orissa Technical Colleges Association Vs AICE & anr. ordered as under:

"....AICTE shall now proceed in accordance with the Approval Process Handbook for the Academic Year 2014-15 insofar as the members of the petitioner Association and all colleges and institutions situated similarly to the members of the petitioner Association are concerned and necessary orders shall be issued by AICTE within ten days" (Copy enclosed)

Subsequently Hon'ble Supreme Court on May 9, 2014 has passed the following order:

".... prior approval of AICTE compulsory and mandatory for conduct of a technical course including the Management / MBA course by an existing affiliated Technical College and also new Technical College which will require affiliation by a University for conduct of its Technical Courses / Programs for the academic year 2014-15". (Copy enclosed)


