DECISION

The House confirmed the Minutes of the last meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.02.2023.



ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD ON 08.02.2023

DECISION

While discussing action taken report on Item no. 07, the Dean, Faculty of Humanities & Languages proposed to include HoDs from Departments of Arabic, Islamic Studies and Persian in composition of visiting teams for physical verification of madaris as per the past practice. It was also proposed that any two representatives from these departments will form the quorum.

Prof. Majid Jamil pointed out that the University could not hold Convocations for the last three Academic years. He requested that University may take an early decision in this regard.

While taking up the matter on Item no. 08, Prof. Mukesh Ranjan highlighted the importance of SWAYAM vis-à-vis the tri-partite MoU to be signed by the JMI with the UGC and Ministry of Education wherein SWAYAM has a significant portion. He reiterated that the University could not be able to take significant steps in implementing the SWAYAM. After discussing the matter in detail, the House resolved that a Committee may be constituted for effective implementation of SWAYAM in the University. A Nodal Officer from each Faculty will be nominated by the Dean of each Faculty. The House authorized the Vice-Chancellor to constitute the Committee.

While discussing action taken report on Item no. 14, it was mentioned that Urban Studies is an interdisciplinary subject and highly in demand. Therefore, the proposal for creation of a new Department namely, Department of Urban Studies may not be rejected. The Vice-Chancellor may be authorized to constitute a Committee in this regard which will submit its recommendations in due course.

While discussing action taken report on Item no. 17, it was highlighted that in Ordinance 15-B, modalities regarding giving admission to those aspiring students from other institutes to Jamia Millia Islamia in 2nd, 3rd and 4th year, may be ascertained so as to bring more clarity.

While discussing action taken report on Item no. 24, it was observed that in regard to courses offered in the Department of Hospital Management and Hospice Studies, the syllabus of the programmes do not contain the portion of hospice studies. The Dean, Faculty of Management Studies assured the House that the Department is working on the same and the desired changes in the syllabus will be made from the next semester.

TO CONSIDER LEGAL OPINION ON THE PRE-REQUISITE OF THE COMMON UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE TEST (CUET) AS AN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSIONS TO COURSES OF THE UNIVERSITY

DECISION

The House deliberated the issue in great detail. The members were unanimous in their view that it has been noticed that the quality of students being admitted through CUET is far below in comparison with those admitted earlier through Entrance Examination. Moreover, the result of courses conducted through CUET was declared very late thereby affecting the entire admission process in JMI resulting in great difficulties to the students as well as the administration. It has also been observed that in majority of the courses where admissions have been made through CUET, a large number of seats remained vacant.

It has been highlighted that Jamia Millia Islamia is not only an autonomous institution but it is a minority institution as well. The Ministry of Education has taken a categorical stand in its affidavit filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi that CUET is not mandatory for all Central Universities and the Central Universities are governed by their autonomous nature in respect of admission to courses of the Universities.

In the light of the above, the House unanimously resolved that the University should have a relook to the courses already allotted to CUET. It was also resolved that the courses which are offered in Self-finance mode be not allotted to CUET. The House authorised the Vice-Chancellor to constitute a Committee in the matter.

The Academic Council also endorsed the following decision of the Faculty Committee of Faculty of Engineering & Technology held on 19.12.2023 regarding requirement of GATE in M.Tech. admissions:

"The admissions to the M.Tech. programmes of the Faculty of Engineering & Technology will be preferably based on the performance of the candidates in Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) (applicable only for GATE qualified candidates with marks more than or equal to the qualifying marks in the respective categories) valid at the time of admission. However, the admissions for the remaining seats will be through Entrance Test held at Delhi. Entrance Test will be conducted for all M.Tech. programmes and rank list maintained for all categories."

The rank list of the entrance test for M.Tech programs will be operated only when there are seats available, after admission of GATE qualified candidates, in each category.

The above may be included in the University's Prospectus 2025-26.

The House, while endorsing the proposal of the Faculty Committee for introduction of three B.Tech. programmes under Self-Finance Mode namely, i) B.Tech. Electrical & Computer Engineering in the Department of Electrical Engineering; ii) B.Tech. While discussing Creation of Foreign/NRI quota in BDS Programme, the House noted that at present there is no quota for foreign/NRI students in the BDS programme of the University. As supernumerary seats are not permissible as per the rules and regulations of the regulatory body i.e. Dental Council of India, therefore, as proposed by the Faculty Committee, 2 seats (4%) for foreign/NRI students out of 50 seats in the seat matrix for BDS admissions may be approved. This move would be in compliance with the GOI initiative to facilitate foreign/NRI students to study in Indian HEIs.

The seats would be allocated from each category of seats, in seat matrix, on a year wise rotational basis. In the event of foreign/NRI student seat remaining vacant in MCC counselling, the seat would revert back to the category from which it was taken for the particular year. As per the Supreme Court orders, all the seats in BDS course, including proposed foreign student/NRI seats would be filled only through MCC counselling process.

The fee payable by students admitted on foreign students/NRI seats may be determined by the University once the creation of foreign/NRI student quota is decided.

The House approved the proposal of the Faculty Committee regarding charging of fee of US\$50,000 from Foreign/NRI students for the complete BDS course which will be payable in one instalment and would be non-refundable with the following components:

- 1. Laboratory & Clinical Training Charges Fee USD40,000/- to be deposited in the Deposit Account of Faculty of Dentistry
- 2. Foreign/NRI fee USD10,000/-

Thereafter, the House resolved that the matter may be referred to the Executive Council for approval.
