



The 5 years of contract are over on 27.04.2020 and the university has not extended the MoU nor interested in extending the same as 'Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute for Literary and Historical Research in Unani Medicine' has not done any remarkable work in these 5 years.

It was further explained that the CCRUM failed to do any of the activity till date and that the contract has also come to an end on 27.04.2020 and the organization has over stayed by more than one year. A total area of 247.50 sqm. is under possession of the CCRUM. As per contract, the CCRUM need to pay the rent, electricity and water charges. The CCRUM is also not paying these charges for the last six years.

Thereafter the Vice-Chancellor apprised the house about the distress faced by the JMI employees during the pandemic (Covid-19) spread in the recent past and she emphasised the need of a Covid Care Centre (Quarantine Centre) for the preparation of possible third wave of Covid-19 and the place occupied by the CCRUM will be the best place for the Quarantine Centre being on the Dr. M.A. Ansari Health Centre premises.

The Majlis (EC) taking cognizance of the matter that there is a dire need of setting up of 50-bedded Covid Care Centre for the employees of the Jamia and as MoU with CCRUM is already over on 27.04.2020, the Majlis (EC) resolved that the CCRUM may be asked to urgently vacate the area/space in which 'Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute for Literary and Historical Research in Unani Medicine' is housed to start Covid Care Centre. It was also resolved that as per MoU the rent of the building along with electricity charges / licence fee may also be claimed from the CCRUM from 28.04.2015 the date on which the MoU was signed till date.

As the Majlis (EC) resolved to approve setting up of a 50-bedded Covid Care Centre on this location before expected third wave of Covid-19, therefore, there is an urgency of getting this space vacated by the CCRUM.

## CONSIDERATION OF SETTING UP OF A 50 BEDDED "COVID CARE CENTRE" SPECIALLY FOR JAMIA STAFF FOR (INITIAL CARE ONLY)

The Vice-Chancellor explained in detail about the dire need of the University for the setting up of a 50-bedded Covid Care Centre for the Jamia staff and only to give initial support to them. She also informed that Jamia teachers, through their Association, have desired the need of such a quarantine centre in JMI. For this Covid Care Centre, Jamia teachers had also promised donations by staff and faculty members. Donation be also invited from Alumni and donors from within the country and from outside.

To collect funds for this Covid Care Centre from national/ international alumni donors and staff, a special account has been approved by the Finance Committee at its meeting held on 28.06.2021 and by the present Majlis (EC). This account will be opened in an identified bank and called as "Jamia Alumni & Donor Endowment Fund". University Development Funds and Donations be used for setting up and conduct of Covid Care Centre which will not be free.

The Majlis (EC) was also apprised that the Level 1 of Dr. M.A. Ansari Health Centre will be earmarked for the proposed Covid Care Centre. The available space in the Lower Level 1 of Dr. M.A. Ansari Health Centre, for the present, will be utilized for placing as many beds as possible. After getting the space vacated, so occupied by the CCRUM, more beds will be added. The utilization of facilities and available staff of the Dr. M.A. Ansari Health Centre and Dental College will be explored to serve in this Covid Care Centre.

The possibility of starting evening specialized clinics inviting eminent doctors may also be explored by a Committee set up by the Vice-Chancellor for this purpose.

The Majlis (EC) resolved to approve, in principle, setting up of a 50-bedded Covid Care Centre in JMI under Dr. M.A. Ansari Health Centre as a Quarantine Centre for the initial preliminary support for JMI employees during expected third wave of Covid-19. It was clarified that the Covid Care Centre will not be able to handle acute cases needing ICU, Ventilator etc. for which the patients are expected to be move to proper hospitals by their family at the earliest.
