## 16 JMI researchers feature in Stanford University's coveted global list of top 2% scientist

It is a matter of great pride for the Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) that the Stanford University, USA has included 16 researchers from the institution to its list of top 2% scientists in the world. The list, released by the world-renowned university a few days back was prepared by a team of experts led by Prof. John Ioannidis, the eminent Professor at Stanford University and published by Elsevier BV, .

Imtaiyaz are included in both the coveted lists while in the 2020 list of top 2% scientists, Prof. Abid Haleem, Prof. Rafiq Ahmad, Prof. Tabrez Alam Khan, Prof. Mohd. Javaid, Prof. Arshad Noor Siddique, Prof. Musheer Ahmad, Prof. Faizan Ahmad and Prof. Tarikul Islam have been included.

The publicly available database of over 100,000 top scientists provides standardized information on citations, h-index, and citations to papers in different authorship positions and a composite indicator.

Scientists are classified into 22 scientific fields and 176 sub- fields. Career-long data are updated to end-of-2020. The selection is based on the top 100,000 by c-score or a percentile rank of 2% or above.
