Thousands of alumni attended JMI Alumni Meet at the university campus, donated lacs of rupees for a school meant for special children

JMI Alumni from all over the world gathered at the M.A Ansari Auditorium lawn, JMI to celebrate Alumni Day. This was the second Alumni Day function organised by Alumni Association of JMI (AAJMI) and Global Jamia Alumni Network (GJAN). Jauhar Award ceremony was also organised during this function to felicitate the alumni who are doing very well in their respective fields.

Vice Chancellor, JMI, Prof. Shahid Ashraf was the Chief Guest and Registrar JMI Mr A. P. Siddiqui (IPS) was the Guest of Honour in the function. Delhi cabinet minister Mr Imran Hussain, Former UP cabinet minister Mr Kamal Akhtar, RJ Naved, Swami Cheteshwaranand were some of the notable alumni, who attended the function.
