Historic performance by students of Economics of JMI in UGC NET/ JRF Exam

In an outstanding performance, 22 of the 32 Post Graduate students from the Department of Economics, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) have cleared UGC NET/ JRF Exam this year.

Out of the 32 students, 19 have qualified for National Eligibility Test (NET) for lectureship and 3 for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) in the all India test conducted by University Grant Commission (UGC).
