German expert conducts workshop on MoJo for faculty members of JMI's AJK-MCRC

A five-day workshop on mobile journalism (MoJo) was organised at the Anwar Jamal Kidwai Mass Communication Research Centre (AJK-MCRC) of Jamia Millia Islamia(JMI) from 2nd to 6th December 2019. Faculty members of the centre participated in the workshop.

The workshop, titled 'Mobile Reporting: The Swiss Army Knife for Journalists' was conducted by Ms. Gwendolin Hilse who is both a journalist from DW and an instructor at the DW Akademie. She came especially from Bonn (Germany) to train the faculty members at the centre.

The faculty-participants in the MoJo workshop were from the Masters courses in Mass Communication, Convergent Journalism, Visual Effects & Animation, Development Communication and PG Diploma in Broadcast Technology.

The workshop was coordinated by Imran Alam and Maryam Zehra, faculty members at AJKMCRC.

The workshop concluded with Gwendoline Hilse, on behalf of the DW, distributing certificates to the faculty-participants.

The participants now feel that they have acquired a set of new professional skills that can be incorporated into the courses that they teach at the AJK MCRC.
