**International Conference on “Prospects and Future of Health and Well-being” at JMI**

The Department of Psychology, Jamia Millia Islamia is organizing a two-day International Conference on “Prospects and Future of Health and Well-being” from March 12-13, 2019 with the purpose of elucidating on the diverse notions and experiences of health and well-being that are constrained by contexts and relations, particularly from the perspective of those at the margins.
