Interdisciplinary International Workshop on 'Leonardo da Vinci' at JMI

Faculty of Architecture and Ekistics, Jamia Millia Islamia, in collaboration with Istituto Italiano di Cultura, New Delhi is organizing a three-day Interdisciplinary International Workshop on Leonardo da Vinci.

The workshop will be conducted by Dr. Chiara Rostagno (Director, Museo del Cenacolo Vinciano, Milan, Italy).

This workshop will provide lectures, activities and a “final forum” for presenting and discussing the Leonardo’s Legacy with regard to diverse approaches and disciplines like engineering, anthropology, mathematics, art, anthropology, architecture and design, biosciences, history, English literature, geography and mass communication. It is critically important to link Leonardo da Vinci legacy and the culture and background of the participants.

The aim of the workshop is to provide an opportunity to the participants for exchanging of approaches and sensibilities in the reading and discovering of Leonardo da Vinci and his significance for next generations.

The workshop has garnered overwhelming response with participation of 150 students from over 22 departments of the university and outside.

Akhtar (Head, Department of Architecture, Faculty of Architecture and Ekistics, JMI).

Chiara Rostagno is an Architect and a PhD specialized in the restoration of monuments. She spearheaded a preservation project of Leonardo da Vinci’s “The Last Supper” between 2016 and 2018. She is the Former Director of Museo del Cenacolo Vinciano (2015-2018).

Rostagno is currently applying the activities of the Mibac/CNR/Unimib team on a research program called "Leonardo" (2019-2023) for the heritage conservation.

She is the author of several books and papers in the field of Conservation and History of Cultural Heritage.
