## JMI organises International Conference (Online) On "Building Resilient and Sustainable Societies: Emerging Social and Economic Challenges"

The Department of Geography, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) organized an International Conference (Online) entitled 'Building Resilient and Sustainable Societies-Emerging Social and Economic Challenges' under the aegis of UGC-DRS-1 Program on 25<sup>th</sup> -26<sup>th</sup> November, 2020.

During the two day conference comprising of 20 technical sessions, more than 140 research papers from different parts of India and abroad including USA, Germany, KSA, Japan, China, Thailand, Bangladesh etc. were presented.
