NIRF-2021: JMI 6th Top University of the country, improves rank from 10th last year

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) secured 6th rank among the 'Top 10 Universities' of the country in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)-2021 Rankings released by the Hon'ble Education Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan today. JMI significantly improved its position from 10th last year in the NIRF. The Ministry of Education, Government of India had initiated ranking of higher educational institutions in the country in 2016.

Expressing her delight over the improved performance of the university, Vice-Chancellor Prof. Najma Akhtar said, " this achievement is all the more significant because of the challenging time the country and university has been facing due to Covid-19 pandemic and also in the light of increased competition in the ranking."

She also said that this achievement was possible because of the relevant and focused research of highest quality and teaching by the dedicated and devoted faculty members of the university.
