JMI to adopt Common University Entrance Test (CUET)

Jamia Millia Islamia(JMI) will adopt the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admitting students in undergraduate programmes for the 2022-23 academic session. It has been decided in a meeting attended by the top officials of the university that admissions for selected undergraduate courses will be done through CUET. The university has communicated to the University Grants Commission (UGC) and National Testing Agency (NTA) about the same.

Students are advised to follow university websites www.jmi.ac.in and <http://jmicoe.in> for updates regarding courses and other details. Students who are interested in applying for those courses will have to fill online forms of CUET as well as JMI.

As per past practice the university will admit students in B.Tech programme on the basis of score in JEE and admission in BDS programme will be done on the basis of score in NEET. B.Tech aspirants are required to fill JEE form as well as JMI
