JMI organises Job-Readiness Workshop in association with IBM SKILLSBUILD-CSRBOX

The University Placement Cell (UPC), Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) organised the first Job- readiness workshop in partnership with IBM-CSRBOX SkillsBuild.
