JMI Professor's *The Paradise of Food* among five shortlisted Indian Novels for JCB Award

The novel has been translated into English as *The Paradise of Food* by Prof. Bara Farooqui. The value of the award is 25 lakh rupees and the translator also gets award money of 10 lakh rupees separately. All the five authors whose novels have been included in the list will get 1 lakh each.
