Vigilance Awareness Week in JMI, employees take Integrity Pledge

With corruption being one of the major obstacles to economic, political and social progress of the country, employees of Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) today took an integrity pledge to build a corruption free institution and the country. The pledge was administered by Prof. Nazim Husain Jafri, Registrar, JMI and Prof. Ejaz Masih, Chief Vigilance Officer (CVO) in Hindi and English respectively at the lawns of the main administrative block of the university.

The pledge was administered as part of Vigilance Awareness Week being observed in the university from October 31- November 06, 2022 to emphasize the importance of integrity in public life and show its commitment to implement the policy of 'Zero Tolerance against Corruption'.
