A German delegation visits JMI for expansion of academic cooperation

An international delegation from the University of Applied Sciences, Erfurt, Germany called on Prof. Najma Akhtar, Vice Chancellor, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) to explore academic and research cooperation between the two institutions. The delegation was led by Minister Wolfgang Tiefense, Minister of Economy, Science and Digital Society, Thuringia and Prof. Dr. Frank Setzer, President of University of Applied Sciences, Erfurt.

The delegation had an extended interaction with Vice Chancellor, Deans, Faculties of Study and HoDs from Engineering & Technology, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences and Architecture. There was an open discussion for expansion of partnership in new domains of learning that involve cutting-edge research and technological intervention.
