Swachhata Hi Seva 2024: JMI employees took Swachhata Pledge, 'Safai Mitra Suraksha Shivar' to be organised on 1st October

Employees of Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) took 'Swachhata Pledge' today as part of 'Swachhata Hi Seva-2024' fortnight in the main Administrative Block of the university. Mr. M. Nasim Haider, Officiating Registrar of JMI administered the pledge in English and Prof. Indu Virendra in Hindi. 'Swachhata Hi Seva' fortnight is being celebrated in the varsity from 14th September to 1st October and it will culminate in the 'Swachh Bharat Diwas' celebration on 2nd October, the birthday of Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi.

Teachers and non-teaching staff of the varsity pledged to remain committed towards cleanliness and devote time for this. They will neither litter nor let others litter and will initiate the quest to cleanliness with themselves, their family, locality, village, and their workplace. The pledge taking ceremony ended with the hope that every step taken towards cleanliness will help in making the country clean.

Swachhata Pledge taking ceremony was organized in several other departments and centres of the university also where teachers and students pledged to keep the campus, surrounding, city and the country clean.

As part of the #SHS2024, Dr. M. A. Ansari Health Centre of the university will organize a 'SAFAI MITRA SURAKSHA SHIVIR', a health camp for all 'Safai Mitras' on 1st October, 2024.
