Mahtab Alam Rizvi and Mr. Rajesh Pratap Singh, Secretary, BSB in presence of Dr. Nidhi Gusain, Education Officer, BSB, Prof. Tanuja, Dean, Academic Affairs, JMI, Prof. Pankaj Kumar Gupta, Dean, Faculty of Management Studies, JMI, and Prof. Sarah Hussain, Head, Department of Tourism and Hospitality Management, JMI.

Prof. Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, Registrar, Jamia Millia Islamia shared the key highlights of the university.
