Jamia Millia Islamia Hosts Delegation from Indonesian Private University Association (APTISI), Central Java

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) hosted a high-level delegation from the Indonesian Private University Association (APTISI), Central Java, comprising forty delegates representing eighteen leading universities. The visit aimed to explore avenues for academic collaboration, research partnerships, and cultural exchange, laying the groundwork for future MoUs and MoAs between Jamia and Indonesian institutions.

The delegation was led by Prof. Dr. Mudzakkir Ali, Chairman of APTISI and Deputy Chairman of the Wahid Hasyim Foundation, along with Dr. Nanang Nurcholis, Rector and Head of International Office & Partnership, and an alumnus of Jamia's Department of Islamic Studies.

The event was organized under the guidance and leadership of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. Mazhar Asif, whose vision for strengthening Jamia's global academic footprint continues to inspire the university's international initiatives. Prof. (Dr.) Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, Esteemed Registrar, extended his support to ensure the smooth facilitation of the delegation's visit, reinforcing Jamia's commitment to administrative excellence and institutional cooperation at the global level.

Prof. (Dr.) Ushvinder Kaur Popli, Dean, International Relations, extended a warm welcome to the delegation and presented an overview of Jamia's academic evolution, international outreach, and excellence in research and innovation. The meeting identified potential collaborations in Fine Arts, Design, Law, and Management Studies, and proposals for Bahasa Indonesia language courses at Jamia.

The delegates, including Prof. Faud , Educational & cultural Attaché from the Indonesian Embassy, commended Jamia's hospitality and institutional depth, expressing optimism for sustained collaboration between Indian and Indonesian universities.

In her concluding remarks, Prof. (Dr.) Ushvinder Kaur Popli stated: "This visit reaffirms Jamia's commitment to fostering global partnerships that promote inclusive education, shared research, and cultural understanding. The vision and guidance of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Mazhar Asif and the steadfast support of Registrar Prof. (Dr.) Md.
